This fact sheet provides information and guidance for opportunities to receive training in Broadband Technology (CTECH) and Medical Billing and Coding (MBCC) programs.

Who is eligible to receive training?

- All Veterans can qualify
- Ages 18 years or older
- Must have a high school diploma
- Must show proof of picture ID
- Must show proof of SS#
- Orleans Parish resident only
- Dislocated workers, unemployed, & underemployed in hospitality industry (i.e. fast food/restaurant)

What are the requirements?

- Must attend information sessions
- Must take TABE entry exam
- Must attend one week of Computer Literacy class
- Must be ready to commit to 3 6 months of training
