➤ Who is eligible to receive training?

- ↳ All Veterans can qualify
- ↳ Ages 18 years or older
- ↳ Must have a high school diploma
- ↳ Must show proof of picture ID
- ↳ Must show proof of SS#
- ↳ Must be drug-free
- ↳ Orleans Parish resident only
- ↳ Dislocated workers, unemployed, & underemployed in hospitality industry (i.e. fast food/restaurant)

➤ What are the requirements?

- ↳ Must attend information sessions
- ↳ Must take TABE entry exam
- ↳ Must attend one week of Computer Literacy class
- ↳ Must be ready to commit to 3 – 6 months of training
